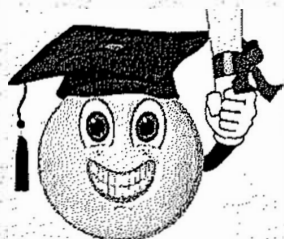

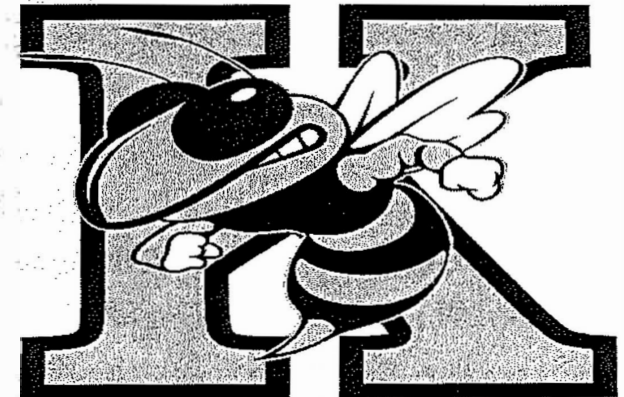

Kearsley Community Schools is proud to offer the 7th Hour Credit Recovery program—a great opportunity for students to make up lost credit. Courses in Science, Social Studies, Mathematics, English and Spanish will be offered for the 2018/2019 school year.

The cost of the credit recovery program is \$50 per class. Please note the \$50 per class payment is nonrefundable.

Students will complete a 12 week course. Sessions are two hours in length, two days per week. Courses in Social Studies, English and Spanish will meet on Mondays and Tuesdays, while Math and Science will meet on Wednesdays and Thursdays. There is an expectation that students will spend an equal amount of time from home on homework. Students must complete all course requirements with a passing grade in order to receive 1/2 credit.

The courses are a computer based program which allows students to work at their own pace. All classes will be facilitated by a certified teacher.

Registration:

- Begins on Monday, October 29th.
- Students must register with their counselor in the Guidance Office.
- Checks can be made out to “Kearsley High School” at the time of registration. Registration will be accepted in the Guidance Office (Room 111).
- Students are only allowed to register for classes which they have failed previously.

Attendance Policy:

- Classes begin on November 12 and run through February 14. There will not be classes on days that Kearsley High School has half days or school is not in session.
- Students who miss more than three class periods will be removed from the program.
- Classes will be held in Rooms 601 and 602.
- Classes begin at 2:25 and end at 4:25!

Student Expectations:

- All rules included in the Kearsley Student Code of Conduct apply within the 7th hour setting. First time offenders will be written up and referred to the assistant principal. A second offense will cause the student to be dismissed from the program. The student will not be allowed to participate in future after school credit recovery opportunities.
- Students must complete all course requirements for a passing grade.
- Students are expected to be in class on time everyday, prepared for class.
